

# ***Cypress - peach Syndrome***

Allergic cross-reactions between cypress and peach have been reported, including an oral allergy syndrome (PMID: 16942582). Patients sensitized to peach were mainly positive for the peach-nonspecific lipid-transfer protein. Profilins or thaumatins could not explain the observed clinical association between cypress and peach (PMID: 23205629). On the contrary, LTPs seem to be much probably involved in the syndrome, as suggested in 2007 (PMID: 22312935)
